REVISIONS: Revisions are indicated in bold text.

Ad To Bid/Bid Opening: - Due to the COVID-19 Pandemic and the Illinois Governor's Executive Order 2020-10, the District will be holding this bid opening via video conference. The bid opening can be viewed via Zoom Meeting. A copy of instructions to Respondents is attached. THIS REVISION DOES <u>NOT</u> ALTER THE BIDS DUE DATE OR NOTICE OF AWARD, DATES.

1. Section 00300R REVISED BID FORM: - Contractor to disregard the previous Bid Form in the Project Manual and utilize the attached REVISED Bid Form (00300R) attached to this Addendum. The BID FORM has been revised to include two (2) additional Alternate Bids (No. 3, and No. 4) as follows:

Alternate Bid No. 3. - Work includes sealing up openings where exterior Transite fascia board panels are removed as applicable with reinforced poly sheeting. Asbestos Contractor to verify exact locations in field. For the purpose of this bid an estimated 2,250 square feet will require seal-up with reinforced poly sheeting.

Alternate Bid No. 4 - Contractor to provide an allowance including: COST PER NOTIFICATION, COST PER MOBILIZATION, and COST PER MAN-DAY, for small scale and short duration abatement work, regarding similar scope work at five (5) other district school buildings including: Lincoln, Willow Bend, Paddock, Whitely, and Central Road School Buildings, in the event suspect ACBM is encountered and confirmed present that may be impacted by planned renovation work associated with and/or following selective demolition of ceilings, walls, etc.

2. **Section 01010 PROJECT SUMMARY: - BASE BID Paragraph A:** The revised Scope of Work for the for Marian Jordan Elementary School and Walter R. Sundling Junior High School is as follows:

MARIAN JORDAN ELEMENTARY SCHOOL: The revised scope of work under the Base Bid includes gross removal using mechanical means, NO chemical mastic removal of approximately 7,500 square feet of ACBM floor tile and mastic and associated carpeting from nine (9) drawing designated classrooms: 01, 02, 03, 04, 05, 06, 07, 08, and 09. General Contractor to remove existing millwork/cabinetry prior to mobilization of the Asbestos Contractor.

WATER R. SUNDLING JUNIOR HIGH SCHOOL: The revised scope of work under the Base Bid includes Substantially intact removal of approximately 3,010 square feet (approx. 188 panels) of asbestos containing exterior Transite fascia board above exterior windows on the east elevation facing the street side/main entrance to the school building. Work to include labor and materials to install primary critical seal with one layer of 6 mil poly on the interior when/where applicable. General Contractor to install new fascia board panels following ACBM Transite fascia board removal work.

3. Section 01010 PROJECT SUMMARY: - Paragraph 1.4 C. Project Schedule:

WALTER SUNDLING JUNIOR HIGH SCHOOL - The completion date for the exterior Transite facia panel removal has been extended to July 3, 2020.

4. Section 01310 ABATEMENT SCHEDULE: - Paragraph 1.3 Supplementary General Conditions; Subparagraph B Projected Abatement Work Schedule:

WALTER SUNDLING JUNIOR HIGH SCHOOL - The completion date for the exterior Transite facia panel removal has been extended to July 3, 2020.

5. Section 02081 NON-FRIABLE ASBESTOS REMOVAL: - Paragraph 3.02 Performance; Sub-Paragraph C - Exterior Transite above Windows: REVISED WORK PRACTICES AS FOLLOWS:

REVISED WORK PRACTICES - Intact Removal of Exterior Transite above Windows at Walter R. Sundling Junior High School

- 1. Provide 6 mil poly drop cloth on exterior ground below area where exterior Transite fascia is to be removed. Extend poly at least 3 feet from building.
- 2. Attach caution barrier tape to construction cones or equivalent to establish a regulated area around perimeter of work area (poly sheeting and window area). Post OSHA signage at the mid points on the barrier tape each side.
- 3. Coordinate with the General Contractor and associated Electrical Contractor, the removal and/or disconnection of an estimated ten (10) exterior lights, electrical boxes, the removal of the awning by the receiving dock, and the removal and/or demolition of School Name Lettering at the front (main) entrance to the building.
- 4. Provide a critical primary seal with one layer of 6 mil poly on the interior to create an air-tight barrier at locations when/where building interiors will be exposed to the exterior following Transite removal work (see Alt. Bid No. 3).
- 5. Un-bolt, un-screw, or cut using HEPA equipped/shrouded tools as applicable manageable sections of the transite panels above existing windows. Contractor shall take all precautions necessary to prevent major damages to or breakage of existing windows/window frames during removal of the ACM exterior transite.
- 6. Spraying/misting, using amended water, shall be conducted at all times during removal.

- 7. Sections of the transite shall be wetted, placed in burlap and double bagged or double-wrapped and labeled as Asbestos Waste.
- 8. ACM shall be loaded into Asbestos Dumpster as work progresses.
- 9. After removal of transite, HEPA vacuum all visible debris from exterior window locations.
- 10. Following step 9 at each location, seal up exterior locations where Transite is removed with reinforced 6 mil poly sheeting. Abatement Contractor to furnish/install temporary weather barriers as required. Coordinate with all other trades.
- 11. Remove poly drop cloth, barrier tape, and signage and release the area to the General Contractor on site for panel replacement by other trades.
- 6. Section 02082 ASBESTOS ABATEMENT: Paragraph 3.02 Performance; Sub-Paragraph B Description of Removal Work Practices: NOTE 2 IS REVISED AS FOLLOWS:
 - 2. Remove all non-ACM baseboards to access ACBM flooring materials. Carpet that is glued down to skimcoat material must be disposed of as ACBM waste. Remove all ACBM floor tile using wet methods. At Marian Jordan Elementary School, the removal of floor mastic shall be conducted using Wet Mechanical Means with HEPA Capture Methods. NO chemical shall be used shall be conducted at Marian Jordan Elementary School. Perform prompt clean-up of visible debris and proper double bagging/disposal procedures. Conduct all gross (wet) removal work in accord with IDPH 855.460 and 465.

- 5. Complete the work in accordance with the contract time as specified in the Project Manual Section 01010.
- 6. Include in his/her bids to remove all designated asbestos containing materials as indicated in Project Manual from the three (3) school buildings (Base Bid), the district accepted Alternate Bids (No. 1, 2, 3, and/or 4), and including additional, unforeseen materials revealed during execution of work in his/her base-bid price.

THE BIDDER MAKES THE FOLLOWING REPRESENTATIONS AND CERTIFICATIONS:

- A. A surety company has agreed to issue Bonds required by the Bid Documents for my work if my bid is accepted by Community Consolidated School District #15.
- B. All work will be performed by licensed personnel or contractors as required by applicable state trade licensing laws.
- C. The Bidder is not barred from contracting with any unit of state or local government as a result of violating bid rigging or bid rotating provisions contained in 720 ILCS 5/33E-3 and 720 ILCS 5/33E-4. Also that the Bidder is not bared from contracting with the State of Illinois as a result of a bribery conviction per 30 ILCS 505/10.2. The Bidder has certified and completed Document 00495 "Non-Collusion Affidavit."
- D. The Bidder will abide by, certify, and provide, a Drug Free Work Place per Document 00485, adopt or have adopted a sexual harassment policy per Document 00487, and certify and be willing to submit to a criminal background investigation per Documents 00488 and 00489.
- E. The bidder will pay, at a minimum, the Illinois Department of Labor's Prevailing Rate of Wages per Document 00825.
- F.
